Upon receipt of this signed form, a key will be issued to the parent for the child to use at their parent's discretion. Keys for juniors will be charged at £3.00
- **Clubhouse Keys** will be given on request to adult members at an additional cost of £8.00, which is refundable on leaving the Club
- Any person, adult or junior, playing for a **Grantham Tennis Club Team** must be a member of the Club
- Parents/Guardians of **Mini Juniors** can play free of charge with their mini junior and do not have to join the Club
